Present position: Professor of Szczecin University, director for Poland of the European Master “Law and Policies of European Integration: European Constitutional Law and Multilevel Constitutionalism” the first example in Europe of a joint Master in law between university belonging to different countries (France, Italy, Poland, Spain).



Studies and Academic Titles: Studies in Law at the Catholic University of Milan (LLM, 1986), PhD in Law at the Catholic University of Lublin (1994), and the habilitation in Law at the same University (2002).

Former full time positions: Since 2005 professor at Szczecin University. In the years 2003-2007 professor at the Catholic University of Lublin and chair of the department of European Union Law. At the same university: 2002-2003 (associate professor), 1991-2001 (assistant professor).

Part-time affiliations: 1998-1999, study service of the Italian Constitutional Court, 1995-2000, of the Polish Constitutional Tribunal, 1990-1992 Polish government adviser for local governments (Lublin region); part-time consultations for the legal aspects of transnational transfer of technology and transnational development of infrastructures.

Main scientific results: the development of a theory of constitutionalism and of an interdependence based theory of constitution, suitable to explain constitutional transitions; a contribution to the study of constitutions founded on meta-theories of constitution (constitutionalism) and complementary theory of constitution (economic analysis); an approach to the study of fundamental rights based upon an enlarged comparison (referred to legal culture, time and space) and the study of the existential manifestations of the human person; the development of a theory of teaching of law, which is able to join different traditions of thought (Indian, Arab, Common Law and Continental Law), and is able to radically increase knowledge communication, professional skills, and abilities to work in team;

Other scientific interests: Economic Analysis, Theory of Language, Theory of Society, Political Philosophy, Complexity Hyper-complexity and Law, Theory of Management, Application of Law to Technology and to Decision Making Processes.

Interdisciplinary application of the results: Integration of the teams of students into the university research (such as for the Grant Epogender); transnational integration of groups of students of law and of other specialities in selected activities such as “The Great Green Wall” (La Grande Muraille Verte”): an initiative of African Union addressed to combat the desertification, to the reconstruction of the biosphere and societal relation in the Sahel region (Senegal 2012, 2013 and the related documentary film “The Great Green Wall”); contribution in the conception of the platform “Pensiero” an expert system addressed to prevent, monitor and combat novel psychoactive substances (since 2012); neurophysiology and decision making process in courts (since 2014).
