

Bartłomiej Kędzior - graduate of the Faculty of Law at the University of Wrocław, where he graduated in 1999 defending a Master's thesis "Supervisory prudential norms in the new banking law", written under the supervision of prof. Fojcik-Mastalski. For several years he worked as a lawyer for the companies involved in construction projects, in 2003 he became chairman of the management board of City Management – a company providing services of project management and management of office buildings; he was also a member of the Supervisory Board of the investment company Phoenix Group. In 2004 -2006 – secretary of the Board of Directors of Vratislavia Holdings in Luxembourg investing in real estate in Poland.

In 2007, he was a co-founder and President of the Management Board of Prime Project sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Wrocław.

As the Director-General, he coordinates major areas of activity of Prime Project sp. z o.o.: investment consulting, technical consulting, comprehensive services for construction investment projects (investor's supervision, project management, investor representation, contracts engineer, etc.), commercialization, real estate management (commercial and residential). The company specializes in comprehensive services for residential/commercial constructions, especially public utility facilities. Among the largest projects currently supervised there is the Center for International Education in Wrocław, including, among others, two-storey school building of the planned usable area of almost 10,000 m², and the construction of the Archive of Wrocław University of Technology. Currently, Prime Project sp. z o.o. manages buildings of a total area of approx. 130,000 m² in Wrocław and Poznań.

Moreover, Bartłomiej Kędzior supervises and participates in the work of the Legal Department of PP, specializing in civil law (real estate transactions) and administrative law (construction law, land-use planning). He is fluent in English.
