Łukasz Hardt, PhD in Economics, Chair of Political Economics at the Department of Economic Sciences, University of Warsaw. He specialises in the economics of transaction costs, the economics of institutions and regulations, and the methodology and philosophy of economics. He has been awarded for his research with the scholarship of the Foundation for Polish Science, the scholarship of the Minister of Science and Higher Education for distinguished young scientists, the scholarship of the weekly *Polityka* as part of the “Stay With Us” campaign, and the award of the Professor E. Lipiński Polish Economic Society for his book *Studia z realistycznej filozofii ekonomii*.

In his scientific career, Dr Ł. Hardt has worked with the Institute of Economic Sciences of the Polish Academy of Sciences, where he participated in the work of the team of the Macroeconomic Monitoring Programme “Polish Economy: Forecasts and Opinions.”

Dr Łukasz Hardt has been Visiting Professor at the University of Cambridge, and has been on research visits with the University of London, the University of Helsinki and the University of Milan. He is a member of the Science Studies Committee of the Polish Academy of Sciences. In 2015, he was appointed by President Andrzej Duda to the National Development Council.
