

Marek Lusztyn, Ph.D.

Since June 2017 Marek has held position of Vice President of the Management Board supervising the Risk Management Division. Before returning to Poland in June 2017, Marek was also a member of the Executive Committee in charge of risk management for UniCredit Corporate and Investment Banking Markets

Previously, between 2000 and 2008, Marek was Head of Market Risk Trading Book Unit and subsequently Head of Financial Risk Department at Bank Pekao, responsible in this role for Asset Liability Management of the Bank. For 8 years he was also a Member of the Supervisory Board of CDM Pekao S.A, equity brokerage subsidiary of the Bank.

Marek started his professional career at Bank Handlowy w Warszawie S.A as currency and fixed-income trader in Treasury Department.

He holds Ph.D. in Economic from the Warsaw School of Economics, and he is also an alumnus of University of Illinois (Executive MBA) and INSEAD. In 2019 Marek completed an executive program at the Singularity University, Silicon Valley in the area of innovation and new technologies. He also completed numerous courses in the field of banking, finance and management
